**HKTV's Stance on
The Motion under the Legislative Council (Powers and Privileges) Ordinance**

(Hong Kong, 6 November 2013) Hong Kong Television Network Limited ("HKTV") expresses its stance on the motion under the Legislative Council (Powers and Privileges) Ordinance to order the Government to produce all relevant documents in the process and approval of Free TV licence with the following points.

1. The public's rights to access information is a basic civil right that should be respected.
2. Until now, the Government refuses to openly explain the reasons for policy change and the justifications for not granting a licence to HKTV.
3. The Hong Kong public and HKTV has been demanding the truth for 3 weeks. We agree to the views of some of the members of the Legislative Council that it is not necessary to invoke the Legislative Council (Powers and Privileges) Ordinance to intervene if the Government is willing to make reasonable explanation. But the reality tells us that the Government shows no sincerity in resolving the issue. Apart from invoking the Council's special powers, what else we can do to seek justice and to settle social grievance?

If the Government fails to openly make an authentic and detailed account, HKTV calls upon members of the Legislative Council to vote and support to invoke the Legislative Council (Powers and Privileges) Ordinance to demand a disclosure of the relevant documents.
